In order that the Cubs can fully complete the badges during the term it is sometimes necessary to ask them to undertake work at home. I would be grateful if you would encourage your son/ daughter to complete this work. Generally, unless otherwise stated in the programme, there is no time scale to get the work back to me but the sooner it is returned the quicker the requirements of the badge will be completed – Many thanks.

Please take note of any weeks when we shall be meeting elsewhere other than at our HQ and also, on some of these occasions, if it has been necessary to arrange an earlier start and finish time.

There are occasions when we would really appreciate **Parental help** in order that we can undertake some of the activities mentioned particularly to ensure that we have, as a minimum, a satisfactory ratio of adults to children. We try to send out an email after each meeting to advise what we have done during the evening, display a link to our Group Web Site for any photographs taken, to confirm the next week's programme and to give you any other important up-dates including any work that your Cub needs to complete "at home".
